Greater St. Helens League continues its commitment to safely provide athletic opportunities for the student-athletes they serve. League Administrators have developed the following plan to begin the offering of traditional fall sports for all league members.

Student-athletes participating in the low risk fall sports of cross country, boys golf and boy's tennis will begin on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Because moderate and high-risk sports have the requirement of our southwest region meeting phase 2 status, the plan listed below will include football, volleyball, girls' soccer and slow pitch softball. The GSHL has made the decision to attempt to offer girls swim during a later time that will allow more facilities to become available for contests.

- If our region reaches phase 2 by Jan. 25<sup>th</sup> moderate and high risk fall sports will begin practices on Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>.
- If our region is still in phase 1 on Jan. 25<sup>th</sup>, league officials will evaluate to see if our region reaches phase 2 on Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>. If so moderate and high risk fall sports season will begin on Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>
- If our region is still in phase 1 on Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>, league officials will evaluate to see if our region reaches phase 2 on Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>. If so moderate and high risk fall sports season will begin on Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>. In both of these cases games would remain the same amount with extra overlap into the following season.
- If our region is still in phase 1 on Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>, league officials will evaluate to see if our region reaches phase 2 on Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>. If so moderate and high risk fall sports season will begin with a shortened season on Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup>. If it is determined we cannot begin moderate and high risk fall sports by Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup> then the league will look into moving to a two-season model mixing some fall sports with spring sport offerings and some fall sports with winter sports offerings.

GSHL is waiting for information from the WIAA before they begin discussions on possible dates and order for the following season offerings.
